

CREATING AN ENABLING ENVIRONMENT FOR "Sahkaar se Samriddhi"

The COVID-19 pandemic has adversely impacted a section of smaller enterprises and cooperatives and they are struggling to run their businesses. Many of these societies don't have access to larger markets due to financial constraints, lack of proper training and experience. To help such enterprises cope with the difficult times, the NCUI Haat initiative has been conceived, to assist women led and lesser known cooperatives, by providing them a stall space for their products at an exhibition-cum-sale centre named 'NCUI Haat' in its premises located at a premium location in Delhi.

Though this initiative is for the self-help groups of NCUI field projects, however, to expand the landscape of Indian Cooperative Movement, other self-help groups, specifically women groups are also being given an opportunity to benefit from this novel initiative.

NCUI Haat supports many of the flagship programmes and initiatives launched by Government of India such as "National Livelihood Mision", "Vocal for Local" and "Skill India Mission"
